# **Athletics Carnival – Information for parents**

- ✓ Athletics Day is a fun day for all students with the emphasis on *participation*. We appreciate that there will be healthy competition and a desire to win, but we want to keep this positive and enjoyable for *ALL*.
- ✓ We ask that parents accept the decisions of the staff members overseeing and judging events. We do our best to get it right every time.

#### At Helidon State School we all are Safe, Respectful and Responsible Learners.

- ✓ We may ask some parents to help with some of the events. This is one way that you can be involved with your own children on the day.
- ✓ Points, ribbons, medals, etc.
  - All participants in all events will earn at least 1 point for their House.
  - The 9 13 years events are for championship points and there will be a girl and boy Age Champion for each of these age groups.
  - There is no age champion for 8 years and under.
  - o Ribbons and participation awards:

#### 9 - 13 years

- ➤ Ribbons will be given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place getters for all track and field events.
- ➤ All participants get at least 1 point for their House tally by participating.

#### 5 - 8 years

- ➤ Ribbons will be given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place getters for all *track events* (running).
- > The field events are *participation only*, so there will be no place-getter ribbons given out.
- ➤ All participants in the *field events* will get a participation stamp/sticker/ribbon, and earn 1 point for their house.

#### ✓ Playground equipment

All playground equipment is *out of bounds* for EVERYONE while competition is on – both days. This includes younger siblings who are at school on the day. We thank parents for their cooperation with this.

#### √ Students sitting with parents

- All students are expected to be where they are directed to by teachers during competition. This is a school day!
- o There will be plenty of time for students to sit with their families at Morning Tea and Lunch breaks.
- Students who insist on sitting with their families during competition may be marked 'absent' from school for the day, and therefore, will miss competing for their House.
