Swimming lessons and carnival

I would like to thank parents/carers for their patience in waiting for the 2nd bus to return slightly later than the school finish time. This was an unforseen circumstance that has been unavoidable.

Swimming Lessons have gone well and the kids seem to be enjoying getting into the pool, especially on the spate of hot days this week.

We pay our respects to the traditional owners of the land on which our school is situated.

Queensla Governme **Swimming Carnival** – Our last big sporting event for the year is next Monday December 1st at the pool in Gatton, and is shaping up to be a highlight on our school calendar. For eligible students, please make sure that consent forms are returned (paper copy OR via QParents), and the \$10 payment (QKR or BPoint) by Friday this week. **Buses will leave at 8:30am for a 9:00am start.**

The following *Important information* was in the consent note sent home earlier this week, with a few changes:

- Only students who participate in swimming lessons (Nov 24th 28th) are eligible to attend the carnival.
- Students from Prep to Year 6 who attend are expected to participate in events.
 - o Age Champion medals will be awarded to boys and girls 9 year and older.
 - There will be competetive events in all 3 main strokes and relays over 25m and 50m for students 8 years and older.
 - Students 9 years and older wishing to swim butterfly will need to nominate by Friday 28th
 November. Butterfly swimmers must be competent in this stroke and need to be able to
 swim a 50m lap. Class teachers will collect butterfly nominations.
 - There will also be some novelty events for our younger students and for other students who are less confident swimming 25m or 50m.
- Students who participate in any event will earn points for their House.
- All students attending are expected to sit with their House group and not their parents.
- Students who attend and who want to sit with their parents:
 - o Are to remain with their parents and will not sit with their friends in the House group areas.
 - Will not participate in events.
 - o Will not be able to participate in the free swim at the end of the events (if there is time).
- Parents attending:
 - YES, we love that parents attend to watch their kids participate. There may be an entry fee to pay. We ask that you follow a few simple rules. Thankyou in advance:
 - Your children who are competeing are to sit with their House group.
 - Non-school aged siblings are welcome, but they must remain with parents.
 - School aged siblings are not to attend as spectators as they should be at school.
 - We ask that you do not purchase items from the pool's canteen for your children.
 Doing so in the past has created issues with some children missing events or having to bin items before getting on the bus.
 - If you plan to take your child home early you must sign them out with a supervsing staff member.
- A draft program of events was sent with the consent letter.
- There will be modified instruction programs at school for non-participants.
