Teacher Planning

In the last week of Term 3 our teachers were released for 2 days each to engage in vital professional learning, student achievement data analysis, and curriculum planning for Term 4. They are also looking ahead to start pre-planing for 2026. There will be 2 additional release days for teachers towards the end of Term 4, most likely in Week 9 (Dec 1-5).

Teacher Aide Professional Development

On September 5th, while the students were enjoying a Student Free Day, and the teachers were not required to be at school, our Teacher Aides were busy engaging in vital professional learning to support their capabilities to support the teachers and students in the classroooms.

- Assessments: In the morning I led them in the detailed process teachers go through to plan, prepare and
 implement assessment tasks. This is more than just giving the kids a test. This important professional
 learning helps or TAs better undertstand the role of assessments and their vital role in supporting teachers
 to implement assessments.
- Essential Skills for Classroom Management (ESCM): In the afternoon they motored up the road to Gatton State School to participate in the ESCM program run by the Principal at Tent Hill Lower SS, Christine Allen. This is a well respected program, usually offered to early career teachers, but that is a great refresher for TAs and even experienced teachers from time to time.



2026 Enrolments

- Fundraising done by the P&C heavily subsidises the cost of programs we run such as swimming lessons, school camp and support for chaplaincy.

Swimming Lessons and Carnival

For a variety of reasons, this year our school swimming will be at the Milne Bay Pool complex in Tooowoomba. **Swimming Lessons**

- Daily from Monday November 24th Friday November 28th in the afternoons.
- The cost will be \$55 per student which is an increase from last year.

 The actual cost this year to run this program is \$115 per student. However thanks to the generosity of the P&C and additional subsidy from the school we have done our best to reduce the cost as much as possible.
- A parental consent form will soon be available on QParents, and as a paper copy if needed, with payments able to be made via QKR or BPoint.
