New Principal in 2026

A few weeks ago, I wrote to you to let you know that I will be taking long service leave for all of 2026 and then plan enter the semi-retirement phase of my life. It's been a hectic and exciting few weeks for me at school as I have been preparing a transition that will hopefully be as smooth as possible for my successor.

That being said, I am pleased to announce that your new Principal will be Heather Litzow. Heather is currently the Deputy Principal at Crows Nest State School. She will bring energy and enthusiasm to the role and a strong vision for curriculum and inclusive practices. These elements are essential for the next stage of growth and success for our school.

Heather will visit Helidon next week for a chance to meet the staff and students and to engage in a formal transition and handover process with me. Depending on the time she can be here, Heather may have an opportunity to meet some parents.

- Jaclyn Carson Jaclyn came to Helidon on a temporary basis for 2025 and has done a great job as teacher of our 1/2 class. Jaclyn is an early-career teacher and leaves Helidon with a greater depth of experience and knowledge about the job. Jaclyn has been offered a teaching position at Fairview Heights State School in Toowoomba for 2026. We thank Jaclyn for her contribution to the life of our school and wish her well next year.
- Annika Graves For those of you who remember, Annika accepted a temporary teaching position at Drayton State School for this year. I have recently been advised that Annika has now been permanently transferred to Newtown State School from the start of 2026. Annika was a long-term and highly effective teacher and valuable member of our school community for about 14 years. Annika provided exceptional leadership enabling participation in a range of sporting events for our students at our school and in the Lockyer Zone. Annika is an exceptional teacher, and will be very much missed at Helidon.
- **Jemima Lithgow** Jemima has worked with us in a temporary capacity as an inclusion teacher aide in our P/1 class, supporting students with some complex needs. Jemima's patience and calm personality has been a valuable addition to our staff team.
- Jacqui Graham While not known to most families, Jacqui has been our visiting Speech Language Pathologist for 1 day/fortnight for the past 2 years. Her role in doing speech-language screening on all our Preps, and in managing a caseload of students with speech-language delays and difficulties has been extremely valuable. Jacquie will be taking maternity leave in 2026, and we wish her well with the imminent birth of her third child.
