This funding will be used to

- Provide *all* students with access to the Australian Curriculum through differentiated teaching and learning opportunities with above 80% of all students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English and Mathematics
- Provide differentiated teaching and learning opportunities with 70% percent of *all* students achieving 'at' or 'above' regional benchmarks for reading comprehension
- Analyse and respond to reading data to drive continuous improvement

Our initiatives include

- A 'data literate' community of practice
- A collaborative, inquiry approach to differentiated reading opportunities for *all* students
- Professional development in Universal Design for Learning (UDL)
- Consistency in the recording of support provisions on OneSchool platform
- A *Robust Reader* culture that aims to inspire *all* students across the transition years

- Implementing inclusive practices through a balance of targeted, intensive and explicit teaching through allocation of teacher-aides and teachers (\$74 543.04)
