



# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019, Helidon State School will receive: **\$73 167**

## This funding will be used to:

- 100% of students as 'Robust Readers' making progress in reading comprehension
- All students tracked and monitored on the Literacy Continuum
- Students, parents and staff satisfied that behaviour is well-managed at this school (School Opinion Survey)
- 100% of staff indicating satisfaction with PD (School Opinion Survey)
- Whole school curriculum plan developed
- Differentiated Learning Teacher Plans evidenced as a working document to inform teaching and learning
- 100% student satisfaction with 'My teacher provides useful feedback about my work' (School Opinion Survey)

## Our initiatives include


- Teacher meetings to address problem of practice and engage in Inquiry Cycles
- Provision of professional development to support the Teaching of reading
- Effectively using short-cycle data to inform teaching and learning of reading comprehension
- Engaging the support of the PATL (Principal Advisor Teaching and Learning)
- Building staff capacity to manage components of targeted resources

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Teachers identifying the goals for improvement of all students in reading comprehension
- Providing targeted support for students from trained teacher-aides \$46 000 (plus \$8 441 carry forward from the 2018 I4S plan)
- Providing teachers and the principal meetings to build capacity in the teaching of reading comprehension \$7 000
- Providing digital learning opportunities to support language acquisition (Reading Eggs, Spelling Mastery, Literacy Pro) \$7 043.29
- Building teacher capability with STEM Lead Teacher \$4 000
- Funding phonemic awareness intervention \$9 123.71
- Funding 2018 salaries (teacher aides) (2018 I4S collected January 2019 \$4 767)

**Total (2018 carry forward) = \$13 208 + \$73 167 = \$86 167**
